

Swim Zone Te Aroha Terms and Conditions of Hireage (After hours)

Reservations for private hire of the Swim Zone Te Aroha shall be accepted only at the discretion of the Facility manager.

The hirer(s) of the Swim Zone Te Aroha shall be ultimately responsible for all who enters the Swim Zone Te Aroha during the period of hire. The use of the pools requires the same supervision standards as if the pools were open to the public. Swim Zone Te Aroha accepts responsibility for the safety of any individual who uses the pool as part of a private booking. Therefore a Swim Zone Te Aroha staff member will be present to act as the lifeguard in charge. The lifeguard is to be obeyed at all times. Normal pool rules & pool dress standards apply at all times.

The hirer(s) must place all litter, wrappings, containers and refuse in the bins provided. All children under the age of 4 years must wear a swimming nappy.

For the protection of swimmers, all food and drink is to be kept away from poolside. There is to be no glass or alcohol allowed within the facility.

It is the responsibility of the hirer to report to the manager in any instances of damage to the complex, equipment or fittings and / or injuries to users of the complex. **Any damages will be charged to the hirer.**

Any hirer(s) making use of the barbeque must leave it clean.

The Swim Zone Te Aroha staff will not accept responsibility for unsupervised children. Children under 8 years old must be supervised by someone 16 years or older at all times. If a child cannot touch the bottom of the pool, caregivers must be either in the pool with them, or within sight/within reach, unless they are deemed to be competent swimmers by the lifeguard on duty.

Spa Pool rules – Maximum of 12 people in the spa at any one time.

Group organisers have direct responsibility for the people in their group. Swim Zone Te Aroha staff have the overall authority and management
